Library Books Due Back.

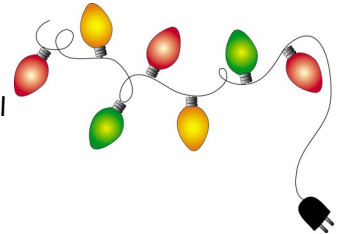
All library books are due back at school. Please ensure that all books are returned so that they can be catalogued back into the system in readiness for 20120.
