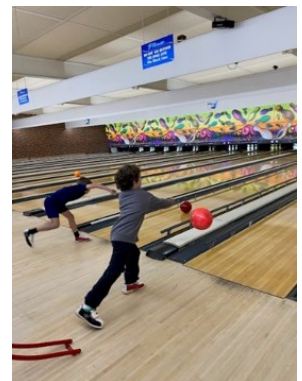


After School Care
