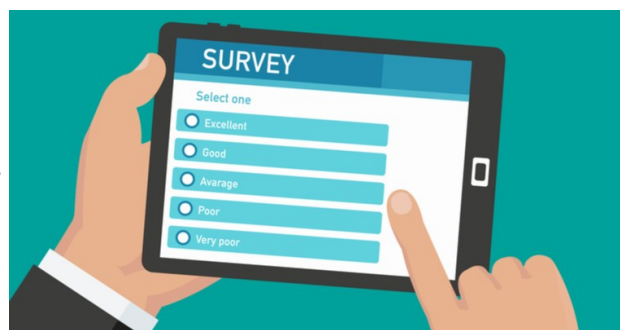

Swimming

All students will have the opportunity to attend swimming lessons at the First Stroke Swimming complex. The lessons will be *30 minutes in duration for the Prep and Gr 1 classes* and *45 minutes for Grades 2/3, 3/4, 4/5 and 6*. The lessons will be conducted by trained swimming instructors. This year we will be conducting the program over three weeks.
