Dental Health Visit

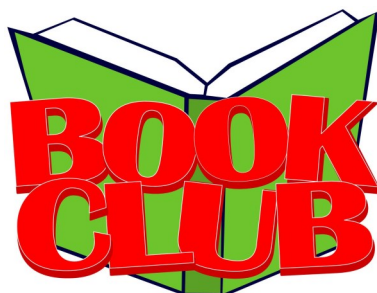
Bike Safety
