Materials Produced By The School

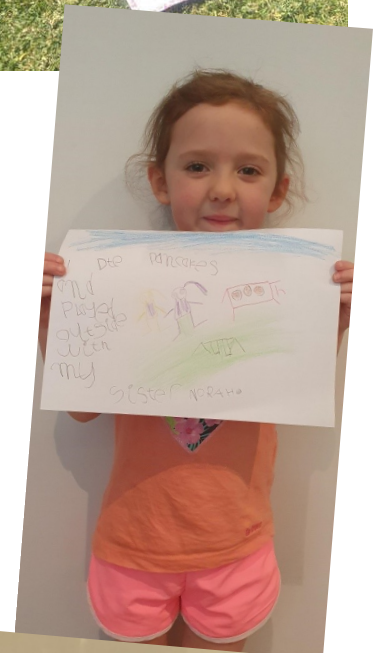
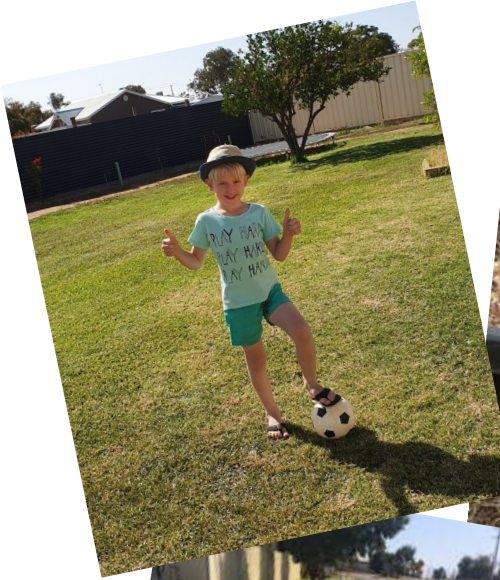
