If you know any families considering enrolling their children at RCEPS in 2022, please let them know about OSHC.

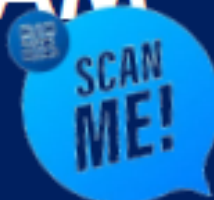
