School Crossing

Medical Action Plans

If your child suffers from asthma, anaphylaxis or allergy, we require an **updated action plan** that has been completed and signed by your doctor. *These plans must be updated annually.*If your child requires any form of medication to be administered at school, you must hand the medication personally (not the child) into the office and complete a medical form explaining how the medication is to be administered. **Medication will not be administered to the child without this form.**


Students do not need to be regular OHSC students in order to attend the full day. Any students can attend so long as an enrolment form is completed.
