Bonney's role in the Primary Welfare position will not be a part of our staffing in 2024. Bonney has made the decision to step away from the role at the end of this year.

The Education Department has made the decision to fund a different role within schools from 2024, and have removed the funding for a Primary Welfare Officer (PWO). The new role must be staffed by a teacher and will focus on the academic wellbeing of students in the classroom. Jodie Judd will take on this role. The role is not the same as a PWO as it focusses on how students are learning in the classroom and what can be done to support their mental health in this process.
