This year we will be conducting Parent Teacher Interviews on Wednesday 24th and Thursday 25th of February. These interviews are designed for parents to meet with teachers for 10 minutes to discuss your child and to chat about the start of the year or any other important topics of conversation.

These meetings are very important for both teachers and parents.

To make a booking please log onto COMPASS. Click on the icon Community icon (2 people) at the top of the page. Scroll down and click on Conference. You should then have the choice of times for both Wednesday and Thursday.

If logging in on a mobile device, simply open the menu selections and select conferences. You will then have access to the times for your child’s interview.

At present we have many parents not allocated to a time to meet with their child’s teacher. Please log onto COMPASS and select a time for either Wednesday or Thursday of next week. If you have issues logging on or cannot locate the times, please ring the school and we will complete the booking for you.

Staff have cleared these 2 days for the meetings as we feel they are very important for your child’s education.

Medical Action Plans

If your child suffers from asthma, anaphylaxis or allergy, we require an **updated action plan** that has been completed and signed by your doctor. These plans must be updated annually.

If your child requires any form of medication to be administered at school, you must hand the medication personally (not the child) into the office and complete a medical form explaining how the medication is to be administered. **Medication will not be administered to the child without this form.**
