

We have a very talented young lady hiding in Grade 6. Her modesty doesn't allow her to share her great news, but that didn't stop her proud Mum from divulging the great result she earnt on the weekend.

This is what Mum shared with us:

"Angel may not tell anyone this, but she was off competing at the Victorian State Junior Championships on Sunday at the Geelong Arena. She was one of the top 80 gymnasts in the State who qualified through the Regional Qualifiers in September to then be able to compete at the State Championships in Level 5 Division 2. This is also the first time she has competed as an individual with just her coach and no team mates as support in what was a much harder division then what she has previously been training for in Division 3. She came 34th out of the top 80 in the State which is an amazing achievement as she has only been training for 12.5 hours per week since August, competing against girls who have training 16 + hours per week the whole year. She had a great comp with no major errors which she can be very proud of, she even placed as high as 11th out of the 80 for her floor routine."
