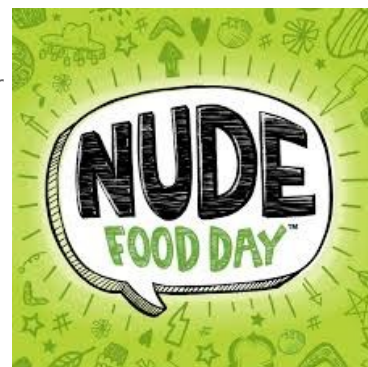
Junior School Council—Friday 28th February
