Return To School

Next Tuesday the Grade 3 to 6 students will return to school. It has been 11 weeks since we have seen them at school and we are all looking forward to reconnecting with the students.



A reminder of the processes we are putting in place for student return to school. We have already put these in place for the return of the Prep to 2 students but we are just reminding our community of what we have in place and also the expectations we have of our community.

- Please remain off site unless you have a genuine need to attend school.
- When picking your child up after school, please keep social distances and do not stay any longer than you need to.
- Students use hand sanitiser when leaving the room and re-entering after recess and lunchtimes. They are encouraged to use the sanitiser throughout the day.
- **Students must have their own drink bottles.** The bottles can be refilled from the school drinking taps but the students may not use the taps directly to drink from.
- We are attempting to social distance in the classrooms as best we can.
- Staff are social distancing in the staff room and the classrooms
- Staff temperatures are taken every morning upon arrival at school
- Cleaning times have been increased. Common touch points (door handles etc.) are cleaned throughout the day. Playgrounds are sprayed with disinfectant after recess and lunch every day. Student tables are cleaned twice a day.
- Students or staff with any symptoms (e.g. coughing, high temperature) are to remain at home.
- All visitors to school must enter via the office and **do not go directly to classrooms.**

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It is very important as community that we do not become complacent now that some of the restrictions are being eased. We certainly do want to go back to stronger restrictions or even a return to remote learning. We are all responsible to do our bit for the greater good.

Semester 1 Student Reports

The 2020 semester 1 report will look different to our normal report structure. This report will focus on 2 specific periods of learning; Term 1 (in class) and Term 2 (Remote/flexible learning). In line with the Department of Education reporting guidelines, we have adapted the Semester 1 report to reflect the unprecedented circumstances that our students and teachers have experienced in recent times.

Teachers will be providing an outline of the content covered in Terms 1 and 2, and also an indication of how your child has managed their learning during this time. Subject progression points will not be given due to the interruption of our normal assessment and reporting schedule that provides the teachers with the data required to make accurate judgements on your child's learning progression.

In term 3, teachers will be available to meet with parents wishing to discuss their child's learning. Semester 2 reports will return to our regular reporting format, providing terms 3 and 4 remain uninterrupted.

The reports will go live on COMPASS on Friday 26th June, and a hard copy of the report will also be sent home on this date.

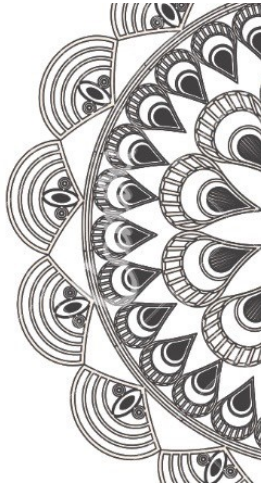
Advertising space in the newsletter for 2020.
