## COVID Updates

As I am sure you are all aware, the district seems to be in the midst of another wave of COVID. Many schools have been dealing with staff and student infection rates on the rise for a few weeks now. We have been fortunate to have missed this at the moment, except for a couple of isolated cases. But this does not mean that our time is not just around the corner.

This morning we have had a positive student and teacher case reported. This does not mean that we are about to have another outbreak in the school, but we can never be sure.

We continue to be vigilant with student hygiene (hand washing) and cleaning of surfaces every day. Please remember that students may wear masks if they wish. I am not sure of the number of RAT tests you may still have at home (I'm sure you have a few lying around) so to be safe and to make sure you have the capacity to test,

we will be sending home a box of tests with every student this week. It is better to test and make sure we keep each other healthy.

The Government has the following advice in terms of isolation:

"Students who report a positive result are recommended to isolate for a minimum of 5 days and not attend school until their symptoms have resolved."

If your child does test positive, please ensure you contact the school ASAP.

We are also in the cold and flu season so we need to test to be sure it is not COVD. In saying that, the flu is just as contagious and can make people very sick so isolating is also recommended.
