At last night's School Council meeting it was agreed that the nightly costs for the OHSC will increase from \$25 per session to **\$30 per session**. This new price will come into effect on the 29th April.

The increase in price will bring our school in line with other school programs who also charge at least \$30 per session.

You will not need to do anything from your end. When we produce the fortnightly invoices (as of the 29th April) the new price will be automatically applied and your current CCS rebate percentage will be applied.
