If you have a Health Care Card, please collect an application form from the office. You must complete a new form every year. If you are eligible, the money will be processed at school and remain on our system for you to use.




Visiting Author

Yesterday the Grade 5/6 class hosted a visit from Conor Pall and Jade Benham. Conor is a local Mildura Senior College graduate who has recently written a book 'The shadow that follows'. The book is about his experiences with domestic violence that meant that he spent most of his time at school feeling like there was a constant shadow lingering over him. His story explains how he managed to

overcome the shadow and move forward. Jade Benham (MP) is supporting Conor and has purchased his book to donate to schools. We invited them both into school to hear Conor's story and to celebrate his successes in overcoming the shadow in his life and how he has become a published author. The students in Grade 5/6 responded positively and maturely to the content covered, asking Conor some great questions.
