## Dental Health Visit

Your child should have received a form last week that needs to be completed if you would like your child to have a free dental health check at school.

The Dental Initiative is a government program that allows for free dental check-ups in schools. If the dentist finds that your child requires further work beyond a standard check-up, they will communicate with you.

The dentist and their assistant will visit our school later this term. In order for your child to be included in this process you must complete the form that was sent home today, and return it to school no later than Monday 8th May. Forms will not be accepted after this date as the forms need to be in the post on this date. If you have misplaced the form please contact the office so we can give you another one.
