

COVID Protocol Update

You will all be aware of the increased numbers of active COVID cases announced in Victoria today. After this announcement the Government has mandated that all adults (12 years or older) and students in years 7 to 12 will be required to wear face masks when outside their homes.

"Most of today's cases are in metro areas. But we have seen a significant jump in regional communities. It's vital we stop this virus further seeping into regional Victoria."

How Will This Look In Our School?

As of Monday, all staff will be required to wear a mask when with other adults. Places such as the staff room and at the front of the school (dismissal time) will be compulsory. When teaching, the staff are not mandated to wear masks, but they may choose to do so.

Students in primary school are not required to wear masks. They may choose to do so, but masks will not be provided by the school as they are not compulsory.

All adults, including parents, who are on school grounds must wear a mask. If they are not wearing a mask they will not be permitted on site, no matter the length of stay.

We understand that this is a very new situation for all of us and we appreciate your understanding in keeping everyone safe in these trying times.

As a staff we will brain storm ways to remotely share some of the events during the day so that our community can still feel a part of their child's successes.



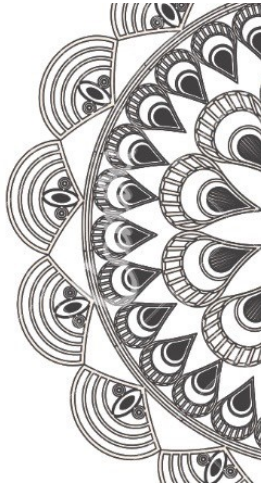
Advertising space in the newsletter for 2020.
