House Award: (Byrne House)

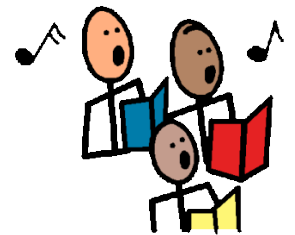
