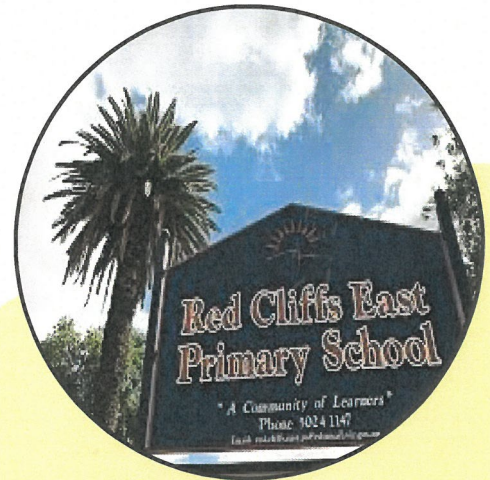
Grade 6 is an important year of leadership, growth and preparation for high school. We are looking forward to a year of learning, independence and memorable experiences for our students.
